- *HIGHLY recommended by myself would be the following books: (reading one or both of these books count as well.
 - * LEARNING HOW TO LEARN
 - *A MIND FOR NUMBERS

Both of these books are by Barbara Oakley Ph.D. These books were written for students and give insight into the mind of students and provide ways students can improve their overall approach to learning. (One or both of these would count as well.)

Entering Grade 7- ELA

Please read a MINIMUM of 2 books, (best way would be one book in July and one in August)

- *The Social Studies curriculum in Grade 7 is EARLY EXPLORERS to PRE-CIVIL WAR, so reading any fiction or non-fiction in these areas would count.
